

Data Dictionary for Statistics on Graduates of Local Full-time Creative Industries-related Programmes

The creative industries-related programmes covered in this dataset are confined to the full-time post-secondary programmes with accreditation as local qualification at sub-degree (i.e. Associate Degree and Higher Diploma) and undergraduate levels.
